The International School on Contemporary Physics - III

The International School on Contemporary Physics - III (ISCP-III) was held on 8-15 August, 2005, Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.

The present school were attended more than 30 invited scientists from abroad and nearly 40 Mongolian participants presented their review reports and research results during the school. The goal of this school is to provide to good opportunity to researchers to share, to discuss and exchange the latest results of research and to establish co-operation between physicists working on contemporary physics problems. The school programme considered talks and contributions presenting researchers. The topics ranging from the fundamentals of Theoretical and Experimental High Energy Physics to the applications in the nuclear medicine and Radiation Biophysics.
